## 2. Fee Schedule?

# e. Testing Fees

1. Spring Test? - \$160 member \$200 or - **\$160 for chapter members and \$200 for non-members.** 

2. Summer Test? - Summer Test Fees. - Jason provided a budget. There was a lot of discussion on this item and we noticed that quite a few items were missing on the budget. The group overall liked the idea of charging more for people who don't substantially volunteer, regardless if they are a member or not. The group voted to charge an extra \$50 for anyone who is not a substantial volunteer during the testing events/leading up to the test/ or cleaning up after the test. Lunches of \$10 value are covered for runners of dogs, judges, and volunteers.

Fees for Summer 2020 test was as follows UT - \$250 non volunteer - \$300 NA is \$225 non volunteer - \$275.

To be reevaluated after this year's test and voted on by board prior to advertising test.

Board meeting was on March 12,2020 at 7:45 pm. Board had a discussion and refined the budget and it was agreed upon that we are going to keep the test fees the same as last year and will keep good track of finances to see if this is appropriate for next year. Fees for the Summer 2020 Test are as follows
